DONEGAL SURGES broke very alertly, saved ground on the first turn, settled off the rail on the backstretch, was urged along passing the nine-sixteenths, dropped from the two path to the inside on the far turn, chased the vanguard into upper stretch, angled out outside the furlong marker, rallied to the lead into final sixteenth then moved clear under good handling. MAMA'S GOLD established a forward position early, raced in the three path on the first turn, prompted the pace on the outside, was asked with a half-mile to run, vied in the two path on the far turn, took the lead coming to the quarter-pole, battled outside of PENTATHLON into the final furlong, led to the sixteenth-pole then was overtaken by the winner while able to get the place. PENTATHLON went to the front, showed the way on the inside while inside of a rival, was asked late on the far turn, lost the advantage approaching the quarter-pole, fought on with the winner until near the sixteenth-pole then weakened but was clear for the show. PIRATE saved ground on the first turn, settled off the pace, was roused in the two then three path on the far turn and lacked the needed response. CERTIFIED LOVERBOY was taken in hand early, tucked into the three path into the first turn, was rated in the second flight, came under urging near the half-mile pole, chased in the three path on the far turn, turned into the stretch in the four path, dropped back into the final furlong and tired. SUN THUNDER went around the first turn in the three then four path, settled on the outside, moved closer with five furlongs to run, chased in the four path on the far turn, turned into the stretch in the five path and was used up. JACKSON HEIGHTS was taken up in tight between horses after the start, angled in quickly at the rear, saved ground on the first turn, settled off the rail on the

backstretch, was urged along with five furlongs to run, went around the far turn in the four then five path and failed to threaten. PADDINGTON was away awkwardly, dropped well back early, raced in the two path on the first turn, was urged along on the backstretch, went around the far turn in the three then four path, remained on his inside lead in the drive and was no factor. DIGITAL OPS went around the first turn in the two path, was well placed towards the front, dropped back under urging late on the backstretch and retreated. FROMANOTHAMUTHA was moving around when the gate latch was sprung and broke near the back, shifted from the four path to the five path early on the first turn, settled off the pace, angled in near the five-eighths pole, raced inside to the two path on the far turn and failed to respond.
