MY LAST MISSION broke out then was hustled to the lead, showed the way down the backstretch, controlled the action while moving from the inside to the two path on the turn, responded well when asked near the quarter-pole, came under a right-handed crop in upper stretch, was challenged on both sides in the final furlong and held gamely under strong urging. KOLOMIO was hustled from the gate, stalked the pace on the outside of the leader, was asked in the two path on the turn, dropped back under urging outside the five-sixteenths pole, turned into upper stretch under a drive, gained into the final furlong then made a bid on the inside, fought with two rivals into the final sixteenth, battled with the winner to the finish and just missed while able to get the place. DR. KRAFT bumped with an opponent shortly after the start, tracked the pace on the outside, was given his cue in the three path on the turn, chased into upper stretch, made a bid outside of the winner near the furlong marker, battled outside of two rivals into the final sixteenth and was outfinished while able to get third. LAND D'ORO bumped with a foe just after the start, settled at the rear, angled in inside the three-quarter pole, dropped back while saving ground under urging for most of the turn, shifted to the two then three path late on that bend, spun into upper stretch in the five path and lacked the needed response.
